COOKIE POLICY

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how Avrion Risk Ltd ("Avrion Risk", "we", "our", or "us") uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit or interact with our website <https://risk.avrion.com/>.

Cookies are used to ensure the proper functioning and security of the website, to analyse how the website is used, and to support marketing and communication activities. This Policy provides information about the types of cookies we use, the purposes for which they are used, and how users can manage their cookie preferences.

Certain cookies are necessary for the operation of the website and are automatically enabled when you visit the site. Other cookies, such as analytics or marketing cookies, are only activated where users have provided their consent through the cookie banner displayed on the website.

For further information on how we process personal data collected through the website, please refer to our Privacy Notice, which should be read together with this Cookie Policy.

2. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on a user's device (such as a computer, tablet, or mobile phone) when visiting a website. Cookies enable the website to recognise the user's device and store certain information about their preferences or interactions with the website.

Cookies serve different purposes, such as ensuring the proper functioning and security of the website, remembering user preferences, and helping website operators understand how visitors interact with the site. Cookies may be set directly by the website operator ("first-party cookies") or by third-party service providers that support website functionality, analytics, or marketing activities ("third-party cookies").

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Cookies used on the website may fall into the following categories depending on their purpose and functionality.

3.1 Essential Cookies

Essential cookies are necessary for the proper functioning and security of the website. These cookies enable core functions such as session management, security controls, and access to certain features of the website.

Because these cookies are strictly necessary for the operation of the website, they are automatically set when you visit the website and do not require user consent.

3.2 Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting information about website usage, such as pages visited, traffic sources, and general user

behaviour. This information helps us analyse and improve the performance and functionality of the website.

Analytics cookies are only activated where users have provided their consent through the cookie banner.

3.3 Marketing / Advertising Cookies

Marketing or advertising cookies are used to measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns and to track interactions with advertising content. These cookies may be set by advertising or social media providers and may track user interactions across different websites.

Marketing cookies are only activated after the user has provided their consent through the cookie banner.

4. Cookies Used on This Website

The table below provides an overview of cookies that are used or may be used on the website. Some cookies, particularly analytics and marketing cookies, will only be activated where the user has provided consent through the cookie banner.

DV	Google	Stores user preferences and interaction data related to Google services used on the website.	Functional	Session
NID	Google	Stores Google user preferences such as language and other display settings when interacting with Google services.	Functional	Up to 6 months
_ga	Google	Used when analytics services are enabled to distinguish users and analyse website traffic through Google Analytics.	Analytics	Up to 2 years
_gid	Google	Used when analytics services are enabled to distinguish users and analyse website usage through Google Analytics.	Analytics	24 hours
_fbp	Meta (Facebook)	Used when marketing cookies are enabled to help deliver advertising products and measure advertising effectiveness through Meta (Facebook) services.	Marketing	Up to 3 months
_gcl_au	Google	Used when marketing cookies are enabled to measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns through Google Ads services.	Marketing	Up to 3 months

5. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies used on the website are placed by third-party service providers that support analytics, advertising, or other website functionality. These providers may collect information about user interactions with the website in order to provide their services.

For example, analytics cookies may be placed by Google Analytics to help us understand how visitors use the website and improve its performance. Marketing cookies may be placed by providers such as Meta (Facebook) or Google to measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

These third parties may process personal data outside the United Kingdom, EU or the European Economic Area in accordance with their own privacy policies. Users are encouraged to review the privacy and cookie policies of these providers for more information about how their data is handled.

6. Cookie Consent

When you visit our website for the first time, you will be presented with a cookie banner that provides information about the use of cookies on the website and allows you to manage your cookie

preferences. Essential cookies required for the operation and security of the website are automatically enabled and do not require user consent.

Analytics and marketing cookies will only be activated after the user has provided their consent through the cookie banner. Users may choose to accept or reject these cookies or manage their preferences where this option is available. Users can also withdraw or modify their consent at any time through the cookie preference options available on the website.

7. Managing Cookies

Users can manage their cookie preferences through the cookie banner displayed on the website. Where available, users may choose to accept or reject non-essential cookies or modify their preferences.

In addition, most web browsers allow users to control or disable cookies through their browser settings. Users may choose to block or delete cookies; however, doing so may affect the functionality and performance of certain parts of the website.
